### Honoring a Northside Neighborhood Hero Pat Body



As a young adult, Pat bought a house on the Northside and fell in love with the area. Since October 2007, she has chaired a Danforth/Pond/Butternut neighborhood group that has made many important strides with a core of very committed residents. In 2009, the group worked with then Deputy Chief Frank Fowler, to open the Butternut Community Police Center. When Wegmans closed their Pond Street store, Pat organized to advocate for a full service grocery store and the Northside Tops Market quickly opened to fill the void. Pat worked with Home HeadQuarters to stage block blitzes on Culbert, DeLong and Spring Streets. Under her leadership, the group conducted a survey of vacant and delapidated housing. The city responded with a pilot program of aggressive code enforcement, marketing of vacant tax delinquent properties, and promoting home improvement resources. Pat is a member of the Citizens Advisory Board for the Land Bank, encouraging available homes on the Northside to be marketed to home owners.
